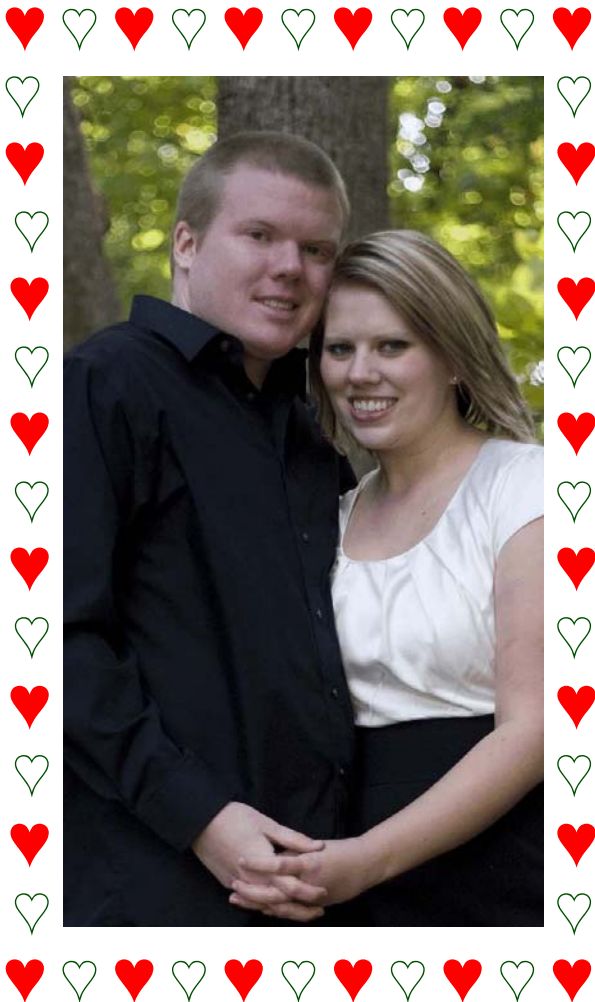

## Coming Up in 2010

**HC100s** – Two of our 100,000-watt shortwave transmitters (shipped in 1990 and 1991) are being returned from Ecuador to Elkhart for refurbishing and modification for service in other parts of the world. One is to go to Australia and the other to Benin, if a shortwave license is approved (please **pray**). We are anticipating their arrival in mid January. **Pray** for wisdom for this major project.
